## INTERIOR.

New-Orleans, September 21.

We are at last enabled, after a long expectation, to fulfill the obligation contracted with the said Bank, on the 16th March ult., of extinguishing the debts of the BEE, in order to give more extent and a better care to the different sections of this journal. We are pleased to make with this opportunity to renew our sincere thanks to those who by their encouragement and benevolence have so powerfully contributed to facilitate us the means of improving this paper, and bringing it to the point it now occupies; but let us throw aside a subject that obliges us to speak of ourselves to explain the nature and motive of the projected absurdities and errors of the paper, which are to day accompanied.

As it has formerly been announced the BEE will hereafter be published on six columns. The great increase of commercial advertisements, the publication of which is granted to us, called for such an improvement, and on another side the extent of our correspondence with the principal cities of the Union and others required we should have more room in our columns consecrated to political and commercial news; the latter in particular where speculations are so extensive as to attract our attention. On this point we will do our best endeavours to prove worthy of the confidence of our readers, and to show that our幼稚的 endeavours have bestowed upon us. These actions on the transactions of the most commanding cities of the North, England, France and Mexico will enable us to keep constantly under their eyes the most important details on that subject.

The English part which hereafter will fill up the first two pages, has received, and will incessantly receive new development; and now it had evidently been neglected on account of the little encouragement we met with those who speak that language—but this being no longer the case we will endeavour to merit the patronage of our English readers, by giving more care to that part and by rendering it as interesting and as varied as the other.

It will be observed that we have suppressed the Spanish side. The rapid and unexpected increase of a fraction of the population of our city, after the promulgation of the law decreed at Mexico for the expulsion of Spaniards had led us to think it would be fitting to the interest of the paper to occupy a column or two in the affairs of Spain and Mexico published in a language common to both nations. Although we have been somewhat encouraged at first by a great number of subscribers conversant with the Spanish, and attracted by the idea of having a paper printed in their language, that would prove a vehicle for their opinions, time soon showed us that this would carry us into such expenses as could not be compensated by the benefits resulting from that source. Therefore have we renounced the idea of presenting any longer that part. Two principal motives have induced us to delay the suppression of it, viz: the importance of the news that we had to publish in that language and the apprehension of disengaging or disappointing a certain number of persons relying on our promises. But now that a great part of the Spanish refugees have left our country for their own, and that the number of our subscribers—most of that nation has evidently diminished: the publication of LA ALTA, would prove too expensive and too costly;—other will be our subscribers dispersed at this moment to return their due while we take leave of them.

We hope the public will excuse the length of these details, as we think it entitled such. Our best wish is to meet with its approbation. We must now speak of our future hopes that are founded on two solid bases, without which there can be no success for us, but with which we can rely on some encouragement—we mean the most scrupulous exactitude in fulfilling our engagements, and the inviolability of our principles; such have been our best recommendations with the public, since the establishment of this paper, and are still now the surest supports upon which we rely—the independence of our opinions has perhaps created us enemies; we would be proud of it. But it has also gained the esteem of just men, and those attached to their country. This is our motto: above all the interest of our country. Let truth be our shield and let us rest it by its consequences and its inviolability; but we are not to be judged on words, but deeds. The time is now approaching when we will once more be called upon to practice what has been expressed, in a great and important question already in discussion.
