FRANCE. Paris, August 11. Yesterday evening at 8 o'clock the departure of the Chamber of Peers had the honor of presenting to the King the address in reply to the speech from the Throne.

His Majesty answered. "Messieurs les Pairs.—I receive with lively satisfaction the assurance you give me of that frank and entire co-operation which can alone insure to my government the force that it requires to answer the national wish, and to consolidate more and more the political order established by the resolution of July 7, 1830."

"I was sure of being approved by my country in taking prompt and vigorous measures from the invasion of Belgium, to support its independence, and to cause the neutrality of a friendly nation to be respected which is bound to France by so many ties, and which so many recollections will always render dear to it."
