From the New York Gazette of June 11th. LATEST FROM FRANCE.

By the packet ship Havant, Capt. ROBERT, the editors of the Gazette have received the files of Paris (up to the 20th and Havre to the 10th ult. The following are extracts from them:—

The Chloera was greatly abated in Azis. There were but 35 deaths during the 24 hours ending on Sunday the 7th, and 32 on the preceding day. It continued its ravages however in the provinces.

The French troops have evacuated Ancona, and the Austrians having received similar orders, and great of them are already on their way.

Cardinal Albani. Another in the name of the Austrian keeps the people in a state of excitement. The Emperor's commission to the Court of Rome is also in the hands of the Emperor's court, as long as the French troops are in Ancona, the patriots were assured by Gen. Coblenz that they might remain in safety.

From the Frontiers, April 27.—Official news of the departure of the French ship of the line Buffon from Ancona, has been announced with this ship having been the last of the Austrians to leave the Adriatic, a great part of the Austrian troops received similar orders to evacuate the pontifical territory, so that five battalions of infantry, four squadrons of cavalry of the line and of the artillery, but a single battery, were the only troops left in Ancona, only remain.
