The bill making appropriations for the contingent expenses of both houses of the legislature, was yesterday handed from house to house. The appropriation to the state printer for extra work employed him, clearly not contained in the specified duties of the office according to the laws of '14 and '26 on that subject, was adopted in the house at \$500. The senate considered his account in detail, and unanimously voted him the sum of \$1125. The house reconsidered this amount and reduced it to \$500. It was so sent to the senate, and concurred in.

This is a specimen of good legislation. What was unanimously approved at one time as just, was in two hours afterwards declined.

A very extraordinary resolution was introduced in the house of representatives yesterday—relative to the official appointments made by governor Wertz during his administration. Had the house the right to take cognizance of the appointments? Has any of the three branches of the government a right to interfere with the proceedings of another? Had not the senate approved of those appointments, and would not a vote of censure passed on the account of those appointments implicate the senate as well as the governor? And has either branch of the assembly the right to censure the proceedings of the other?

If the conduct of the governor demands scrutiny with regard to official appointments, is the hall of assembly a proper place for such investigation? If the constitution has already placed the senate as a check or control over such nominations, why should the house of representatives arrogate to itself that privilege? If individuals of the legislature feel chagrined or disappointed; are they to prostitute their delegated power as representatives to pass laws only, in order that they may act as public censors?

The different fire companies of the city were yesterday chartered by the assembly. Mr. Hoar acted in a highly faithful way by his constituents on the occasion for there was a joint resolution of both houses to take nothing into consideration except messages, enrolled bills and the contingent expenses of the legislature, he had the resolution suspended; and the charter considered. It exempts the members of the fire companies 3, 4, 5, 6 from militia duty except in case of invasion or insurrection, and in serving on juries; and afterwards extends similar privileges to No. 1.

(By Authority.) AN ACT TO REMOVE THE SEAT OF JUSTICE FROM VAN BUREN TO SPRINGFIELD IN THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON.

Whereas, by a large majority of the citizens of the Parish of Livingston praying that a law be passed, to remove the seat of justice from Van Buren to the town of Springfield in the parish of Livingston aforesaid, provided that suitable public buildings be furnished to said parish at individual expense and without charge to the parish. Therefore, Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Louisiana, in General Assembly convened, That so soon as a courthouse and jail shall be erected at the town of Springfield in the parish of Livingston, it shall be known as the permanent seat of justice of said parish.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, That Barlen Childress, Jos. H. Dunnington, and Samuel Richardson of the parish aforesaid be and they are authorized commissioners to select the site on which said courthouse and jail are to be erected. And it is further enacted, That the courthouses and jail be built in virtue of a contract to be made and entered into with those already erected at Van Buren, and that the buildings are to be furnished free of expense to said parish of Livingston, which buildings shall be accepted by the commissioners aforesaid.
