SALES OF STOCKS.—  
NEW YORK, August 1.

GENERAL REMARKS.—In no former season have we received for a full month so large a supply of goods already received and daily expected as that of preceding years, both in extent and value;—several large crops have arrived during the past week, and others are daily expected. Most kinds of country produce are commanding very high prices, and the supply at the time by no means equals the demand. The cotton crop, however, has brought down a number of country merchants, for the purpose of laying in their fall stocks—we may say, therefore, that our fall season has begun.

BaCk—Hands are in demand and very scarce in market, at 14 cts; shoulders at 9 cts; and middlings at 10cts, and are also in demand.

BaRrels—Fruit are in demand.

BaRrels—Foot are at from \$3 to 4 per hundred.
