ARRIVAL OF THE BATTLESHIP
The battleship USS Oregon (BB-3) arrived in St. Paul, Minn., on Monday, July 13, 1915.
The ship was accompanied by the transport USS Albatross (AT-10) and the minesweeper USS Albatross (MS-10).
The Oregon is the only battleship in the United States Navy that has survived the test of time.

THE BATTLESHIP OREGON
The battleship USS Oregon (BB-3) is a member of the Oregon class of battleships.
She was built at the Puget Sound Navy Yard in Bremerton, Wash., and was launched on March 4, 1897.
She was the only battleship in the United States Navy that was built in the Pacific Northwest.
