"How we Pay for Tea.—The imports into the United States from China, in 1844, amounted to \$6,686,171, while our exports to that country were only \$1,320,170—balance against as \$5,366,001. In 1849 our imports were \$11,904,754; exports \$1,400,945—balance against us \$10,343,811. In five years our imports increased felly sixty per cent, and our exports did not increase over twelve per cent. It appears that during the same period, that is in 1844, the exports from Great Britain to China semonited to \$35,926,132, while the imports were only \$17,625,450—leaving a balance of trade against China of \$18,003,772. The principal articles of export from Great Britain to create this large balance against China consisted of raw cotton from British India, and the febrics from her home factories, both of which, and of a better quality can be more cheaply supplied from this country.
