ARMED AND DANGEROUS.—A photograph of the two men who are wanted for the murder of James Bell, the San Joaquin County Sheriff. The man on the left is identified as "Red" McMurphy, and the man on the right as "Lone Wolf." They are described as being between 5' 8" and 5' 10" in height, with dark hair and eyes. They are said to be members of a gang known as the "Black Legion," which is believed to be responsible for the killing of Sheriff Bell. The two men are shown in a dark, shadowed setting, possibly a car or a building at night.

OFFICIAL

After due consideration of the facts presented by your memorandum, I have the honor to advise you that, in my judgment, it would be imprudent to call upon the government to prosecute in this case, as it would be a violation of the principles of justice and of the Constitution of the United States. In view of the above, I desire to offer a reward of \$3000 for the apprehension and conviction of said Joseph Bell, and \$1000 for the apprehension and conviction of James Bell, and \$100 for the apprehension and conviction of John Bell. These rewards are to be paid in full, and no more, to any persons who may apprehend and bring before me, the State of New York, the persons named above.
