OTR CARRIAGE WITH NEW GRAMMA.

Two years ago last April a number of inde-

pendent, helpless and unaided American citi-

zens were subjected to a brutal and unprovoked

assault by an ill-fated band of New Granadi-

ans in the streets of Panama. This atrocious

outrage, which by any other government

would have been promptly and vigorously pun-

ished, has, with the proverbial procrastina-

tion which distinguishes our decisions, been

made the subject of a warlike controversy,

a series of complaints and negotiations,

a commission of inquiry, and several con-

ceivable modes of pacific and ignominious

negotiation. Finally, after the lapse of many

months, a treaty was agreed to, which, in the

past and security for the future, has been

to be attained. This treaty, which was the

work of the Congress of New Orleans, was

signed on the 20th of July, 1887, and is

now before the Senate for ratification.
