LEGISLATIVE DOCUMENTS.

We have before us a mass of records made to
the State Legislature at the present session.

Several of them are extremely interesting, but
our limited space prevents us from the assembly of
referring to them somewhat briefly. One of
the most important is the bill introduced by
the Governor of the State, the "Act to Secure
the State of Louisiana.

It is an elaborate and carefully drawn state-
ment. The history of the war movements of the
State, from the period of secession to the meeting
of the Legislature, is given in full. Within the
limits of the bill there are two bills, one of
which was introduced by the State, and 3570
volunteers independently into the Confederate
service—making a force in the field furnished
by the State of Louisiana of 22,577.

The Adjutant General then refers to the
different measures adopted by the State in the
organization of the militia, and particularly to the
General Order of the 20th September last, issued
by the Governor, which has proved highly
efficient and successful. Of its effect the report
says: "Officers prepared with activity to the
conduct of their duty in the city and vicinity. Com-
munications daily presented to headquarters for
their efforts. It only remains to
arrange them in battalions and regiments, which
will be done in a very short time."

Mr. Tappan introduced a bill appropriating
\$100,000 for State expenses.

Mr. Holmes introduced a bill to appropriate
\$100,000 for the payment of the Confederate
troops who had been retained by the State.

In the Senate a bill appropriating \$100,000
for the same purpose was introduced.

The bill for the sum of one million dollars,
appropriated to construct fortifications, was
passed by the Senate.

On Friday there was a grand review of

mass meeting of the State Convention, at
which the resolutions were carried down as long
as they had been looking toward the "Confeder-
acy." The State Convention adjourned.
