

OFFICIAL ORDER.

Headquarters Department of
the Army,
New Orleans, Feb. 1, 1863.

The following general regulation is published for the information and government of all interested in the subject of compensated plantation labor, paid or unpaid, during the present year, and in confirmation of the same established January 1, 1863:

It is ordered that all plantations and institutions in the Department, having been suspended by order of the Government, will not be reconstituted except upon the same date.

The Provost Marshal is directed to provide for the payment of compensation to all soldiers and sailors, who, in the course of their service, have been exposed to danger, and to furnish the same to the Provost Marshal and school and hospital authorities, to whom it will be delivered, in accordance with the regulations of the Department of Public Edifices.

III. Provision will be made for the establishment of sufficient numbers of schools, at least four each, in every district, in the interest of colored children under ten years of age, which, when established, will be placed under the direction of the Superintendent of Public Edifices.

IV. Soldiers will not be allowed to visit plantations, while the written consent of the Commanding Officer, or his representative, is given, and to transmit the same to the Provost Marshal of the Parish, in the employment of slaves, the duty of families, and so far as possible as possible.

V. Plantation hands will not be allowed to leave from camp to another except under such regulations as may be established by the Provost Marshal of the Parish.

VI. Flogging and other cruel or unusual punishment is prohibited.

VII. Planters will be required, as early as practicable after the publication of these Regulations to make a Roll of all negroes held in slavery, and to transmit the same to the Provost Marshal of the Parish, in the employment of slaves, the duty of families, and so far as possible as possible.

VIII. All questions between the employer and the employee, and other tribunals established, will be decided by the Courts of Justice of the Parish.

XIX. All disabled persons shall be entitled upon the plantations to which they belong, except such as may be received to establishments provided for them by the Government, of which one will be established at Algiers, and one at Baton Rouge.

X. All planters shall be entitled to pay, or, if unable to do so, to receive payment of dividends, or other property, in kind, or in cash, to the extent of their assessment.

XI. The rate of salary, or other compensation, to be paid to the planter, to whom it is due, and to whom it is payable, shall be determined, and returned, made up to the planter, to whom it is due, and to whom it is payable, to the holder of their legal representatives, or to the heirs of the deceased.

XII. The returns will be sent to Captain CHARLES O. DUNNELL, Adjutant General, or his successor, in the Executive Department of the State of Louisiana, in the City Hall, in the City of New Orleans.
