New York, Nov. 7.—Richard papers, of the 7th, give the following, respecting the sinking of the steamer *Albemarle* and the capture of *Pineywood*:

"The captured steamer *Pineywood*, M.C., is now at New York. It is expected to be sent to Europe.

"A boat of sailors was sent ashore on the 5th of November, and the crew were the prime movers of the loss of the town."

"On Tuesday night a party of sixteen men, mostly negroes, were sent from Albemarle Island, nine miles off the coast, in small torpedo boats and started for *Pineywood*.

"They made a small hole, and started for the town, but were driven back by a picket guard. They then passed to the south of the island, and running the torpedoes, it exploded, and sank the ship, blew her up, causing damage from which she never recovered.

"Infantry was stationed on the wharf, who fired on the burning party, and the Albemarle, which had been sent to the rescue, was also engaged.

"The *Pineywood* was sent to the mouth of the river, where she lay at anchor.

"We have no news to-day, but the time of the explosion of the torpedo."

Policy of the North Republic in Mexico towards the North American Slaveholders.

We receive from the Havana *Press* the following extract from the *Confederate*, of Mexico, which states that the slaves in that country, under the circumstances, are a continual destruction of policy by the Government of the United States:

"A section of paramount importance for Mexico is the relation which the force of circumstances has created between the Empire and the Confederacy."

"Whatever may be the issue of the war which divides the two great powers, the policy of the imperial government will be determined by the side on which it falls."
