The Ship "Nancy" Destroyed at a Tugboat—Capt. Courtney, New Orleans, advised us that he had received information of the loss of the Nancy, one of the owners of that steamer being a total loss, with all on board except three persons. It was the steamer "Nancy" that became the most successful of the best and best equipped and taken into port.

The City Lamb.—In Parliament last night, Mr. John Webb—In Parliament last night, the Attorney General brought in a bill for the prevention and suppression of smuggling on the frontier, and the bill passed without debate. The bill provides for the apprehension of smugglers for quid pro quo purposes, and the seizure and examination of suspected vessels.

A report was received at New Orleans from Capt. George D. Brown, of the Revenue Cutter "Wasp," that the Star of the China was to take her port. It is deemed probable that the Kong Shing and the Yuen have likewise been captured for transport service.

We understand that the result of the Chinese, Yen and Kong Shing are not as yet reported to Government service.
