The Tax for Colored Schools.

Many citizens desire information regarding the special school tax which certain persons named in a published list are notified to pay into the hands of the Provost Marshal.

We are not aware of any law under which this tax is imposed. It originated in an order of the General Council in the year 1862, and was amended March 21, 1863, and which created a Board of Education for freed negroes with authority to levy a tax on real and personal property, including any and every property to defray the expense of schools established by the Board for one year, the school year running from the 1st of February, 1863, to the 1st of February, 1864. The tax was levied at the rate of \$1000 upon the assessed value of all property in the city.

It appears that to be entirely lawful in origin and in its intent, the tax should be levied on property which was in the hands of the owner at the time the tax was levied, and which was already heavily taxed by the State, the city, and the United States, would do well to appeal to General Canby who may possibly see the propriety of discontinuing a tax which was a species of war tax, especially as now the Freedmen's Bureau has recourse to its own form which freedmen's schools might be supported.
