The result was that the French army was forced to retreat, and the Prussians entered the town of La Mans.

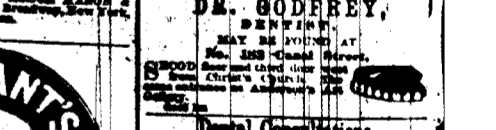
