

SALOON POST OFFICES.

Postal Authorities Discover Irregularities in Large Cities.

Hall of Foreign Laborers Delivered to Their Lodging Places Instead of Places Where They Live.

A practice that has existed for some years of delivering mail in bulk addressed to foreigners in the foreign labor colonies of the large cities, to saloons and other places of general assembly, there to be sorted over and handed out in the crowd instead of delivering at the house addresses, is being generally agitated and complaints are constantly reaching the post office department. The complaints allege that in some cities, like Boston, New York, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and Chicago, a carrier acquainted with the foreign colony is employed, who, knowing the habits of the men, delivers their mail to their lodging places, and that during the campaign of last year there were instances where advantage was taken of the crowds so congregated by making use of partisan speeches and otherwise manipulating politics while distributing the letters. Boston is specifically complained of, the allegations setting out that in some instances the carriers became political bosses. The trouble that has grown out of the practice referred to has vexed the post office department and the civil service commission, and Assistant Postmaster-General Hatch has about decided on a step which may put an end to the trouble. This contemplated posting notices at all of the places where these men meet announcing that it is a violation of the law and of the laws of the post office department to have mail delivered at such places without instructions to have it left there and advising the persons receiving letters that they must have their street address put on their letters or else go to the post office for them.

A REMARKABLE COUPLE.

Man, Aged 107, and His Wife, Aged 105, Celebrate in Michigan.

Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Hiller, living near Elkhorn, Mich., the oldest married couple in the United States, celebrated their eighty-seventh wedding anniversary the other day.

Hiller is aged 107 and his wife 105.

The latter is totally blind and helpless. Hiller is of medium height and build, his step is firm and regular and he is as spry as a man half his age. He reads a newspaper well and without the aid of spectacles. He attends to all the household duties and their home is as cheerful and clean as could be expected from a young married couple.

The couple are from Canada and were married at the ages of 20 and 18 years respectively. They moved to Michigan and have been residents of the state for over 80 years. He was 22 years of age at the beginning of the war of 1812, and now relates very vividly many of his experiences during the conflict.

The family consists of 11 children, the oldest 88 and the youngest 57, all of whom are in good average health and fail fair to make an age record similar to that of their parents.

APPROPRIATION IS ENOUGH.

Improvements in San Pedro Harbor.

Cal-Alger's Fears Groundless.

Secretary of War Alger seems to have little or no foundation for his fear as expressed that the deep-water harbor at San Pedro cannot be constructed for the appropriation of \$2,900,000. It is learned that the Pacific Improvement Company is prepared to file a bid within the limit, and Banning Bros., owners of Catalina Island, have announced that they are prepared to put in a bid for the construction of the harbor which will be inside the appropriation, providing they do not sell their Catalina rock to some other contractor.

Hancock Banning stated that his firm had not yet seen the specifications, but they had figured on the breakwater designed by the board of engineers of 1891 and found that it could be constructed at a profit of \$1,000,000.

FLIGHT OF DAYLIGHT METEORS.

More Than One Hundred of Them Observed by Prof. Brooks.

Prof. Brooks, director of the Smith Observatory at Geneva, N. Y., while taking daylight observations of Mercury the other afternoon between three and four o'clock, observed through the large telescope a wonderful flight of daylight meteors.

They were intensely white, many of them having the appearance of Venus or some bright planet, when seen through a large telescope in the daytime.

The direction of motion was toward the sun. During the passage of the meteors, which lasted half an hour, more than 100 were seen, at times two or three meteors passing through the telescope field together.

Against Shad-Fishing on Sunday.

BUFFALO GNATS.

Myths of the Pest Killing Of Livestock in Texas.

Worry the Animals Until Exhausted and Then Swarm Into Their Nostrils, Causing Death by Suffocation.

Recent overflows in various places of East Texas have given rise to swarms of buffalo gnats, which are causing havoc among stock. Horses and mules have been killed by the hundred, and just at this time, when the farmers need every available work animal, the blow falls with redoubled force. At Big Sandy, Upshur county, 50 head are reported dead already, and the cool weather causes fears that cows and hogs will also be attacked in a short time. The stock continues to suffer, and reports come in every day of further losses.

Weyman, Colorado county, reports 50 head dead in three days, but the weather is turning warmer, which will kill the pests. One hundred and fifty horses have died in Smith county within a radius of ten miles of that town. Reports from adjacent counties indicate great loss from the pest. At Gladewater, Gregg county, 193 head had died, and the farmers were working hard to save the few remaining ones. In Cherokee county 44 head died in two days about Alto, and reports from other parts of the county show as great losses, the losses already reported being in excess of 150. A Queen City (Casey county) report says that from a section of 12 miles about that place reports have come of over 100 head dying, and they are still dying in great numbers. As the carcasses lying in the woods cannot be accounted for for some time, and as only a comparatively few points have been heard from, the loss may be very heavy.

The gnats appear every spring, but not in the number they have this year. They bite the animals all over, worrying them and preventing eating or drinking, keep them on the move all the time until they drop from sheer exhaustion, when the gnats quickly end them by attacking the vital parts, and especially the delicate membrane of the nostrils, crowding in such numbers as to cause suffocation in a short time.

FAST RIDE SAVES HIS LIFE.

Col. Pickett Takes Poison and Searches to a Doctor's Office.

Col. Charles W. Pickett, a republican politician and editor of the New Haven (Conn.) Evening Leader, had a peculiar and narrow escape from poisoning the other night.

On the night in question, feeling somewhat indisposed, he went to the medicine chest and took what he supposed was his tonic.
