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CHARTER

STATE OF LOUISIANA, PARISH OF ORLEANS, CITY OF NEW ORLEANS

BE IT KNOWN, That on this fifth day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and six, before me, the undersigned Recorder of Mortgages, in and for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, appeared the several persons whose names are hereunto subscribed, who severally declared that they were the owners of the land hereunto described, and that they were desirous to incorporate the same under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

ARTICLE I. The name of the corporation shall be the CONSUMERS LUMBER MANUFACTURING AND EXPORT COMPANY, and under its said corporate name it shall have power and authority to have and enjoy separate existence for the full term and period of ninety-nine years, from and after the date hereof, and to do all things which may be necessary and proper to carry out its objects and purposes.

CHARTER

ARTICLE VI. Whenever this corporation may be dissolved, either by limitation of time or by other cause, its affairs shall be liquidated by two commissioners to be appointed amongst the stockholders at a special meeting of the stockholders convened for such purpose, of which meeting notice shall be given in the manner and form provided for in this charter.

ARTICLE VII. This act of incorporation may be modified, changed or altered, or said corporation may be dissolved, with the consent of three-fourths of the capital stock expressed at a general meeting of the stockholders convened for such purpose, and after notice shall have been given in one or more newspapers published in the City of New Orleans, once a week for four weeks preceding the meeting, and by written notice to each stockholder mailed by registered mail to the date of meeting at the Post office address designated by him in writing.

ARTICLE VIII. No stockholder shall ever be held liable for the contracts or debts of said corporation in any further sum than the unpaid balance of the shares of stock owned by him, or any more informally in organization have the effect of rendering the stockholder liable for the unpaid amount remaining due on his stock.
