General statement of the statistics of the State of Louisiana, taken from the official rolls of 1847:

By this statement it appears that there are 35,560 qualified voters. The whole white male population is set down at 105,391; of whom 124 are insane; 34 blind; 41 deaf and dumb; and 5 one hundred years old, and over.

Timber Experts Wanted for European Investigation.

Some real lumber experts are wanted for the important work of finding out what our chances are of selling lumber in Europe when the war is over. The Lumber Manufacturers' Association and the Bureau of Foreign and Domestic Commerce are working together in this investigation and indications are that it will be one of the most important steps ever taken to further the sales of American lumber in foreign countries.

Four or five men are required for the work and they will be employed by the Bureau of Foreign and Domestic Commerce, although the larger part of the fund required will be furnished by the Lumber Association.

Applicants for positions must be citizens of the United States and must be available for two years' service. The first subject of the examination will be practical questions, covering forestry, or timber production; manufacture of forest products; marketing of forest products. For the second subject a thesis on investigation methods will be required.

Ability to write good English is one of the most essential qualifications, and will be judged on the basis of the written examination papers. Good address and appearance will also be considered, as will ability to address public gatherings.
