Law of the congress of Venezuels assent 31 May

Article 1st. All national or foreign vessels arriving from foreign poets into the ports of Venezuels will pay, First—Tomage—duty at the rate of 374 cents for every ton of the vessel's admeasurement.

Second—Captain of the jorts fee which is 33.
Third—Entry—7 cents per ton.
In the part of Lagrayya, besides the 7 cents per ton, amount of duties on imports will be exacted.
